

Energy Delivery Driver

Role Description

The Energy Delivery Driver position is a full-time, on-site role and will be responsible for delivering products to customers in a safe and efficient manner. This home-every-night scheduled role will be engaging with our customers and provide first class service. The Energy Delivery Driver will also be responsible for maintaining accurate records of deliveries and transactions.

Responsibilities:

- Operate and maintain a commercial motor vehicle, such as a propane or refined fuel truck, in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.
- Load and unload goods and materials using appropriate equipment and techniques.
- Plan and execute delivery routes to ensure timely and accurate deliveries
- Inspect and document vehicles before and after each trip to ensure they are in proper working order and report any mechanical issues or damages
- Adhere to all safety protocols and procedures to prevent accidents and injuries.
- Maintain accurate records of deliveries, including mileage, fuel consumption, and any incidents or delays
- Communicate effectively with customers, and other team members to coordinate deliveries and resolve any issues or concerns.
- Follow all company policies and procedures, including those related to vehicle maintenance, hours of service, cargo security, wearing a safety belt, and using hands free devices.
- Keep abreast of industry regulations and best practices to ensure compliance and safe operation
- Represent the company in a professional and courteous manner at all times
- Attend cooperative meetings and work to improve personal skills and knowledge
